- City's contractor will perform camera inspection and make repairs, if warranted, as determined by the City of Chesterfield

Street Tree Program

- The City of Chesterfield maintains all trees located in public right of way.
- The City of Chesterfield performs or contracts for all maintenance on street trees including removal (tree and stump) and trimming.
- If a resident or trustee wants a tree assessed or trimmed, he/she should contact the City at 636-537-4000 or use the “Report a Problem” function on the City’s website.
- Trees can be requested at a cost of \$100 (total cost approx. \$325). There needs to be available space – no conflict with other trees, signs or utilities.
- Right of way is typically the area between the street and sidewalk. If no sidewalk, right of way is generally the area within twelve feet of pavement.



Emerald Ash Borer

- EAB is killing all Ash trees in areas infested, including Missouri. The Emerald Ash Borer is in the City of Chesterfield.
- The City of Chesterfield recently completed the removal of all public Ash Tree – 6,709 Ash Trees.
- Ash trees affected by EAB quickly die and become hazards.

Description

The adult emerald ash borer is a dark metallic green beetle with a bullet-shaped, slender body. When wings are spread, the top of the abdomen under the wings is metallic purplish red. Adults are most active during the day, from late May to mid-June.



City / County / State Roads and Utilities

- The City of Chesterfield maintains approximately **184** miles of public roads.
- Many roads are maintained by the St. Louis County Department of Transportation (White Road, Chesterfield Airport Road, Chesterfield Parkway, Baxter). Residents can contact St. Louis County at 314-615-8538.
- Many roads are maintained by the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT I-64, Olive/Clarkson, Long Road). Residents can contact MoDOT at 314-275-1500.
- Some roads are private.
- The City of Chesterfield cannot maintain private roads or roads owned by another agency.
- The City of Chesterfield does not own / manage / control Utilities

Street Replacement

- The City of Chesterfield has a capital projects fund dedicated to the replacement of City infrastructure.
- Streets are rated every 3 years, and the Capital Replacement Plan is updated annually.
- Grants are obtained when possible.
- \$3 million + in street replacement annually.



Street Repairs

- Streets deteriorate throughout the year due to many factors (age, freeze thaw cycle, joint infiltration, etc.)
- Public Works Staff regularly drive streets in order to assess problems.
- Residents desirous of reporting a problem can do so via the “Report a Problem” feature of the City’s website or by contacting the City at 636-537-4000.



Sidewalk

- The City of Chesterfield maintains approximately 260 miles of public sidewalk, including ADA ramps.
- Sidewalks inspected every three years.
- Currently \$500,000 annually allocated toward sidewalk replacement.
- Residents who wish to report a problem can do so via the “Report a Problem” feature of the City’s website or by contacting the City at 636-537-4000.

Request for Traffic Signs

- A resident desirous of requesting a traffic sign should do so via the City's "Report a Problem" feature of the City's website or by contacting the City at 636-537-4000.
- Some signs (speed limits, no outlet, deer crossing) are set by City Policy.
- Other signs (stop signs, no parking) require support from the Trustees, a petition of area residents, and City Council approval.
- The City Engineer can assist any resident with any request for street signage.



Snow Removal

- One of the most important tasks completed by the City of Chesterfield.
- We watch weather closely and pre-treat when appropriate.
- Two full maintenance crews work 12 hours on / 12 hours off during storm events. Crews comprised of Public Works and Parks personnel.
- Ten snow maps which detail the exact path drivers follow, turn by turn.
- Trucks are monitored by supervisors and a GPS system.
- Windrow Removal Program from driveway entrances for qualifying residents with a medical condition. Contact the Public Works Department (636-537-4762) for details.



Solid Waste Contract

- Solid Waste Removal performed under contract by Republic Services.
- A five year contract was approved by City Council in 2021 covering the period 8/1/2021 through 7/31/2026.
- Base price includes trash and recycling. Senior citizens are eligible for a 15% discount.
- Yard waste service is optional.

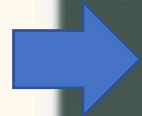

The Department of Planning provides a variety of land use, zoning and development services. Staff is available to assist you through the entire development process. The Department encourages high quality growth and development throughout the City by ensuring compliance with all development standards and design requirements. The responsibilities of the Department include:

- Management of a variety of zoning requests, review of site plans and plats
- Administration of the City of Chesterfield Unified Development Code
- Zoning Enforcement
- "Planner of the Day" (POD) program
- Municipal Zoning Approval for issuance of Building Permits
- Signs
- Issuance of Occupancy Permits
- Comprehensive Land Use Planning

The Planning Staff works on everything from the review of building permits, sign permits, and business licenses to site plan review, zoning petitions, ordinance amendments, and subdivision plats. We are also responsible for zoning code enforcement and development inspections.

City Ordinances

The City of Chesterfield provides several means by which the public can search and view the City's Official Documents:

- 1) **eCode 360** publishes the Code of Ordinances, which is a plain language and completely searchable version of the City's ordinances. Please note that any publication on the General Code website may vary significantly in format and in pagination from the Official City Publication. These publications are made available for informational purposes only and no action should be taken without viewing the Official Copy of the publication as recognized by the Officers of the City of Chesterfield.
- 2) **The City of Chesterfield Digital Ordinance Copies** as signed into law. You can browse by year, or search by Ordinance Number, Bill Number, or Keyword. However, due to the fact that these are scanned images of the physical ordinances, the majority of text within them is not searchable.
- 3) **Digital Copies of Council Resolutions** which are not part of our codified law, but rather formal statements of a decision or opinion of the Council. You can browse by Resolution Number. However, due to the fact that these are scanned images of the physical resolutions, the majority of text within them is not searchable.

Note: also that these documents may be unofficial in that the posted version may only be current through the date posted.

Ordinances adopted after the date posted may be obtained or viewed at the Office of City Clerk, Chesterfield City Hall, 690 Chesterfield Pkwy W Chesterfield, MO 63017-0670, during regular business hours.

- Responsible for investigating retail thefts. (in 2022, they recovered over \$ 100,000.00 in stolen property and responded to over 2800 calls in the City's retail/entertainment areas.)
- Provided over 1000 hours of park patrol activities in 2022.

DEER HUNTING INFORMATION

- The City conducts annual deer counts to determine the extent of the problem and to assist in determining the best and most practical options for addressing this issue.
- Letters were sent out to all neighborhood trustees last year detailing the City's requirements for permitting hunting on any property within a residential neighborhood to include the City's notification of intent to hunt requirement, requirement of liability insurance, etc.

SOLICITING

- Permit needed.
- This does not include the placing of fliers for services, etc. on someone's door.
- Organizations with a valid 501C3 are exempt from the solicitors licensing requirement.
- Solicitors who treat residents rudely or otherwise make a resident uneasy or suspicious should be reported to the police.

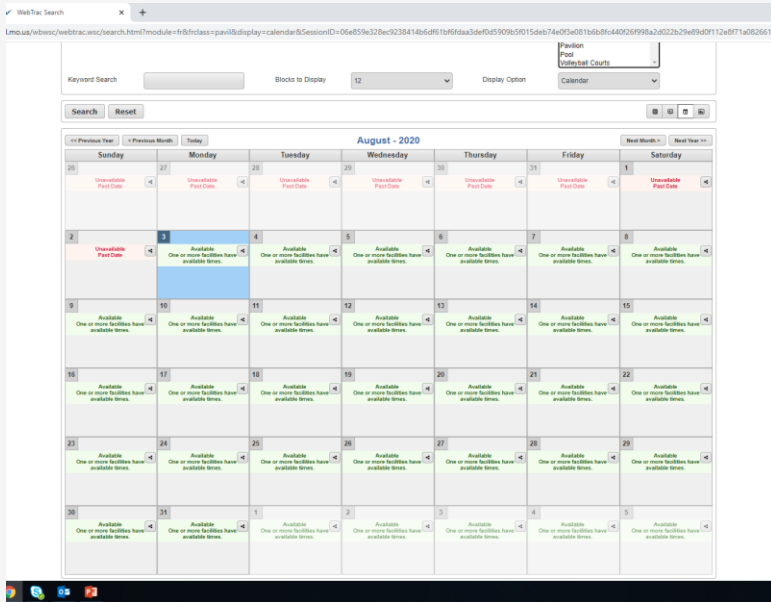

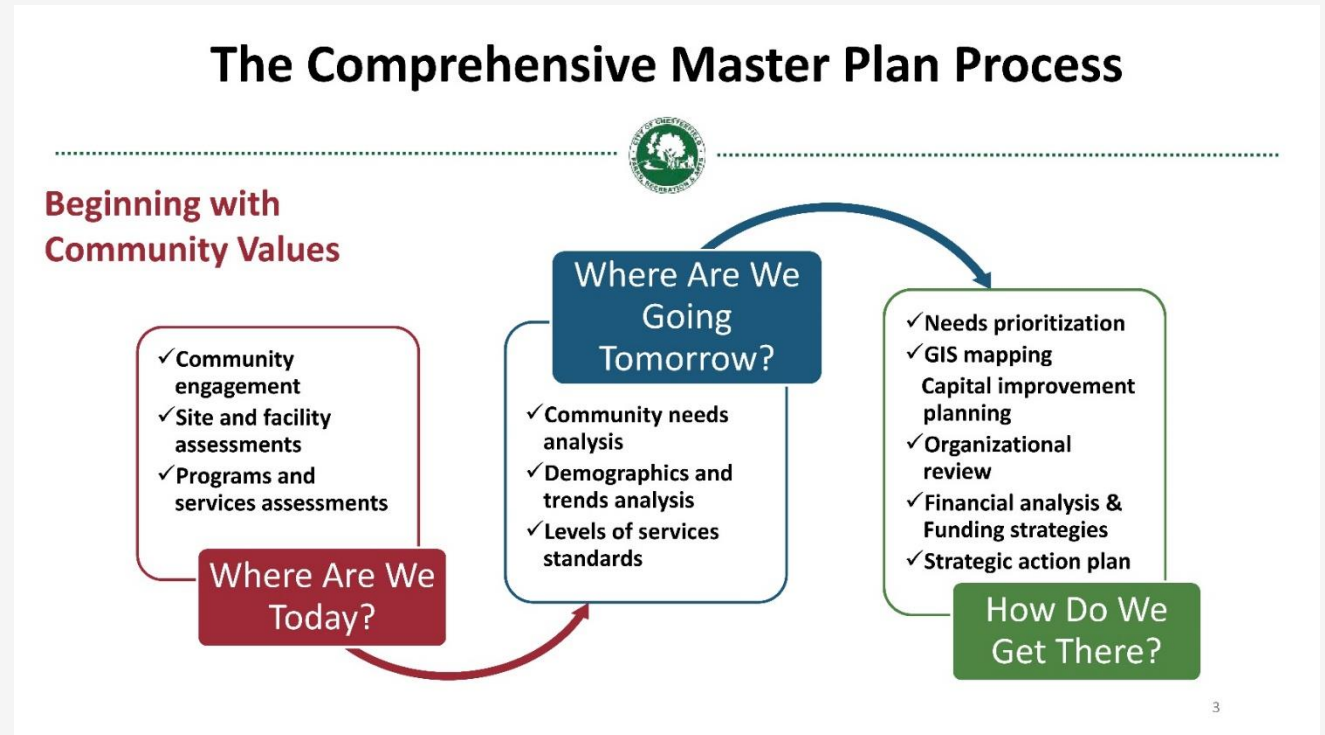
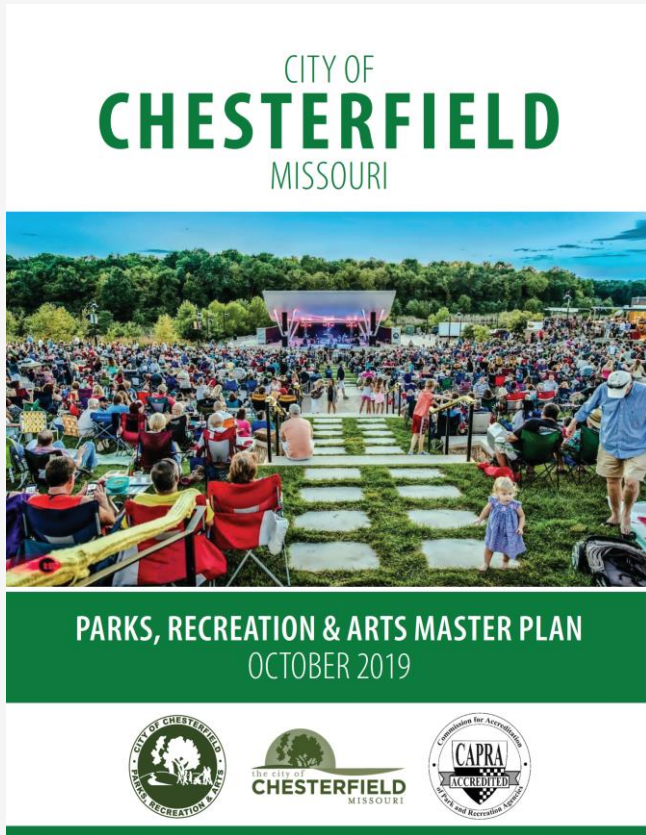

NEW PARK NOW OPEN



Logan University and the City of Chesterfield partnered to create a new public park at 1859 Schoettler Road on Logan's campus. This is the first park in Ward III. Amenities include a 0.3 mile trail loop, a picnic pavilion, two pickleball courts, restroom, storybook walk and an ADA accessible playground. Parking is available as well.

Eberwein trail & dam project



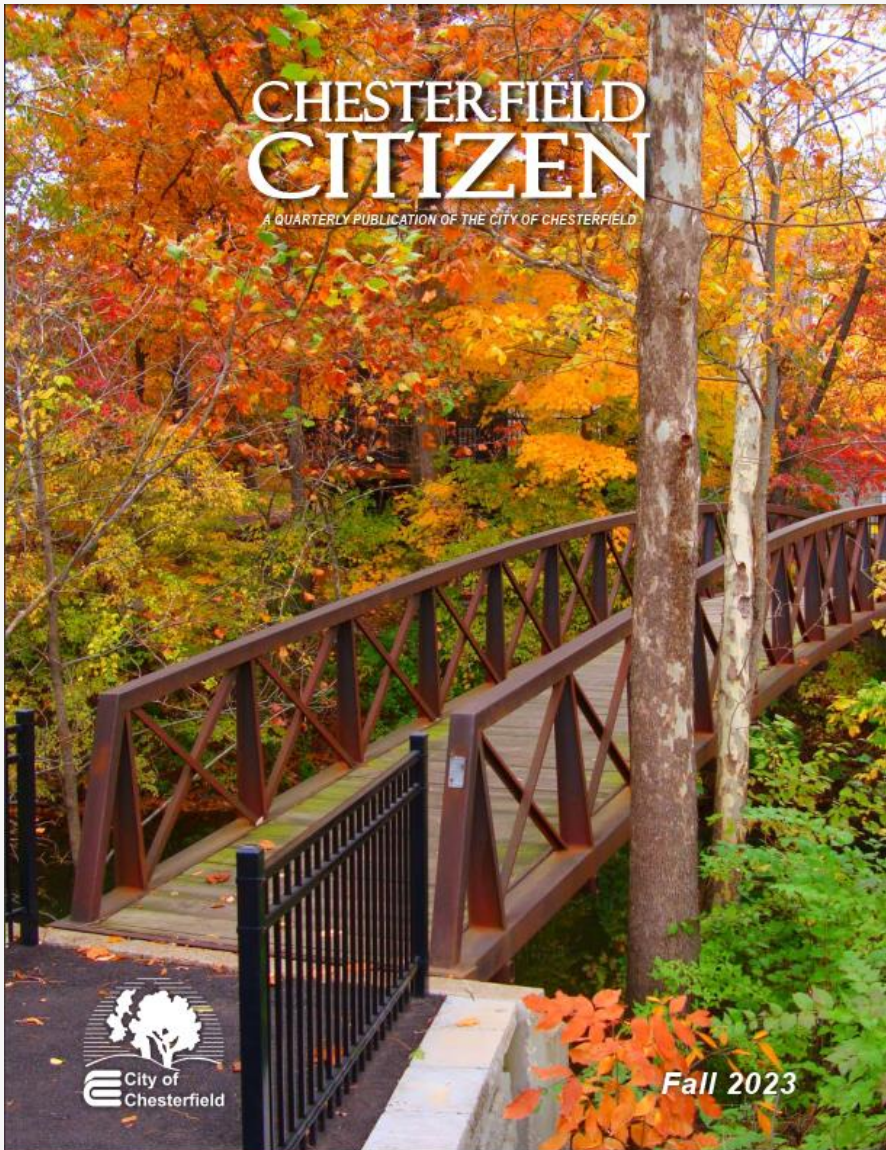
Eberwein Park recently underwent improvements. Aggregate trails located throughout the park were replaced with a new concrete trail. The trail was relocated to minimize the grade and prevent erosion problems that have been affecting the park since originally constructed. While excavating for the new section of trail west of the pond, it was discovered that the dam had several leaks, and needed to be reconstructed prior to trail reconstruction. The pond excavation and dam repair are complete, water quality basins at the northwest corner have been reconstructed, and the park looks great!

Riparian Trail extension

Phase II of the Riparian Trail which begins at August Hill Drive, continues north through Central Park, crosses Wild Horse Creek Road at the Burkhardt Place intersection, and terminates at Old Chesterfield Road has been completed. This project was partially funded through a \$1 million grant acquired through the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP). All remaining project costs outside the grant were funded through the Chesterfield Valley Transportation Development District (TDD), resulting in no net cost to the City of Chesterfield.

Work began on October 11, 2021 and is now complete. The pedestrian signal at the Burkhardt Place/Wild Horse Creek Road intersection was activated on November 14. The entire trail between August Hill Drive and Old Chesterfield Road is now open. Parking for trail users is available at the parking lot for the Family Aquatic Center or on Old Chesterfield Road.
