

AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE AND COLLECT AN ADDITIONAL COURT COST ON ALL MATTERS FILED IN THE MUNICIPAL DIVISION OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD COURT FOR REMITTANCE TO THE INMATE SECURITY FUND.

WHEREAS, Section 488.5026 RSMo. allows the City to assess a two-dollar (\$2.00) surcharge on Court costs for an Inmate Security fund;

WHEREAS, the Inmate Security Fund will be used to establish a biometric verification system for City inmates that will promote public safety with in the City by assisting with prisoner identification..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section as follows shall be added to Chapter 19:

- (a) An additional two-dollar (\$2.00) surcharge shall be assessed and added to the basic Court costs in this Section for the Inmate Security Fund. Such surcharge collected shall be transmitted to the City Treasurer for deposit into the "Inmate Security Fund" which is hereby created. No such surcharge shall be collected in any proceeding when the proceeding or defendant has been dismissed by the Court or when costs are to be paid by the State, County or City. Funds deposited shall be utilized to develop a biometric verification system as provided by Section 488.5026, RSMo. Upon the installation of the biometric verification system, funds in the Inmate Security Fund may be used for the maintenance of the biometric verification system and to pay for any expenses related to the custody, housing or other expenses of prisoners.

Section 2. This new section shall be codified at Chapter 19, Section 19-7(d) of the City Code.

Section 3. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any proceedings pending in any court, or any right acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause, or causes of action, which accrued or exist under any act or Ordinance enacted prior to this date, or any Ordinance hereby amended.

Section 4. Except as amended herein, the Municipal Code, and Ordinances of the City of Chesterfield shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
