AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 35 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD BY ADDING SECTION 300.236 WITH PROVISIONS THERETO TO RESTRICT U-TURN MOVEMENTS AT ELECTRIC TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNALS AND OTHER LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITYOF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to turn such vehicle so as to proceed in the opposite direction at any intersection controlled by a Police officer or electric traffic control signal; nor shall such turn be made at any place unless the movement can be made in safety and without interfering with other traffic. The driver of a vehicle shall not turn such vehicle around so as to proceed in the opposite direction upon any curve or upon the approach to or near the crest of a grade, or at any place upon a roadway where such vehicle cannot be seen by the driver or any other vehicle approaching from either direction along the roadway where the same may create a traffic hazard.

Section 2. In all other respects, Ordinance Number 35 is in full force and effect.

Section 3. Savings.

Except as expressly set forth herein, nothing contained in this Ordinance shall in any manner be deemed or construed to alter, modify, supersede, supplant or otherwise nullify any other Ordinance of the City or the requirements thereof whether or not relating to or in manner connected with the subject matter hereof.

Section 4. Severability.

If any term, condition, or provision of this Ordinance shall, to any extent, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder hereof shall be valid in all other respects and continue to be effective and each and every remaining provision hereof shall be valid and shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law, it being the intent of the City Council that it would have enacted this Ordinance without the invalid or unenforceable provisions. In the event of a subsequent change in applicable law so that the provision which had been held invalid is no longer valid, said provision shall thereupon return to full force and effect without further action by the City and shall thereafter be binding.

Section 5. Penalty.

Violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) and not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000), or by imprisonment not exceed three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
