AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES 1824 AND 1888 OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISSOLVING THE PUBLIC WORKS CITIZENS ADVISORY GROUP

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chesterfield established the Public Works Citizens Advisory Group in 2002 by Ordinance 1824 to aid in the initial development of standards, codes, and procedures to promote the general welfare of the community and to assure that the infrastructure in the City would conform with acceptable community standards; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chesterfield subsequently amended the membership criteria by Ordinance 1888; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works Citizens Advisory Group was extremely valuable and successful in providing technical assistance and developing recommendations which have provided leadership and community support; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield has benefited from the efforts of the Public Works Citizens Advisory Group and respects the time and contributions of its volunteers; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Public Works Committee has reviewed the ongoing need to maintain the Public Works Citizens Advisory Committee as a standing committee and has recommended that it be dissolved; and

WHEREAS, the City's need for occasional professional and technical assistance can be effectively addressed by discipline specific ad hoc committees, the City Council of the City of Chesterfield has determined that the Public Works Citizens Advisory Group should be dissolved.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance 1888 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Ordinance 1824 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. The Public Works Citizens Advisory Group is dissolved.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
