1. Digital/virtual Monarch/Pollinator Nexus Garden Tour for which you said you are going to be taking the overhead photos (18). We announced these and honored the people who made these possible at Earth Day. Tom McCarthy was one such Honoree. We certainly want to help proofread this document and we do request that it also be placed on our city's web site.
2. Powerpoint of excerpts from our CCE Brochure and 2016 Accomplishments to show/tell about CCE to help educate newly elected city persons and newly hired city persons, and to help CCE attract more volunteers of all ages.
3. National Wildlife Federation's Fiscal Report which must be filed by 7/31/17 in order to be reconsidered by the National Wildlife Federation as 'accomplishing post-certification goals,' i.e. be considered as "A Recertified Community Wildlife Habitat." We're 'into' our twelfth year+.
4. Parks Concessions Recyclables Flyers to help educate not just the public/families, but our Coaches, i.e. CCE is trying to help 'coach the coaches' for those concessions/items which can and should be recycled throughout our parks system. (On-going recycling education process for families/businesses in Chesterfield.)
5. 2nd BiAnnual Family Native Gardening Grow-Off - visitation just occurred. Discussion next meeting; honors in October as per Application Form.
6. Joint Letter to National Wildlife Federation for Certification of Community Wildlife Habitat (12+ years) AND CAPRA for Parks, Rec. and Arts National Accreditation (2+? years) requesting a higher, measurable hierarchy for communities with BOTH to include 'points for recertification/achievements' for both, and a national call to those communities with just one to achieve the other. A new NATIONAL more holistic, healthy, measurable, and sustainable habitat format.
