Incarnate Word - Sign Package – A request for a Sign Package consisting of an Electronic Message Center for a 9.92-acre tract of land located on the south side of Olive Boulevard, west of State Highway 141 (16Q311770) **(Voice Vote) Planning Commission recommends approval.
