As directed, we have reviewed the Parks, Recreation and Arts' policies and would like to make the recommended changes. As you are aware, the compilation of Parks policies are included in the Public Works section of the City's Policy Manual, reflecting the original organizational structure of the City. I request and recommend that the following four policies be forwarded to the Parks, Recreation and Arts Committee of Council for review and approval to move forward to the Council as a Whole.

**PW Policy 21 Parkland Criteria:** This policy addresses Parkland Criteria and I recommend no changes.

**PW Policy 29 Donations for Park Improvements:** Currently the policy states, Donations for Park Improvements can either be accepted through Friends of the Parks or directly by the City. I recommend that this policy be updated and modified to read as follows: Proposed donations of real estate for park purposes should be forwarded to the Director of Parks, Recreation and Arts for review and recommendation. The Director's recommendation should be forwarded to the Parks, Recreation, and Arts Committee of Council for review and recommendation to the full Council.

**PW Policy 39 Park Rules and Regulations:** This Policy could be eliminated and we will update the Park Ordinance No.2738 that established the rules and regulations.

Policy 43: City Employee Admission to the Family Aquatic Park: No changes recommended.
