RE:

South Eatherton Road

As you are aware, City Staff became aware of St. Louis County's actions in restricting through tractor trailer vehicles from using South Eatherton Road. Subsequently, both the Police Department and the Department of Public Services has had multiple conversations with motorists and St. Louis County regarding enforcement.

Accordingly, Chief Johnson and I concur that it is appropriate and desirable for the City of Chesterfield to pass parallel legislation, updating our traffic schedules to restrict through tractor trailers from using South Eatherton Road. As will all traffic restrictions on State or County roadways, it is far more desirable to have a municipal companion ordinance for our traffic officers to cite, which can then be addressed in our municipal court.

I have prepared the attached legislation for consideration by our City Council, which restricts through tractor trailer traffic on South Eatherton Road, in a manner identical to the County restriction. Chief Johnson and I jointly recommend its' passage, and I request that this item be placed on the next Planning and Public Works Committee agenda for consideration.

SCHEDULE XII. REGULATION OF THE KINDS AND CLASSES OF TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN ROADS

RE: Request for Regulation of Tractor Trailer Trucks on South Eatherton Road

Dear Mr. Dooley:

Ms. Susan Mueller, Principal Engineer, City of Chesterfield, forwarded a complaint from Ms. Jenny Thissen, 18695 Wild Horse Creek Road, regarding tractor trailer trucks on South Eatherton Road. Ms. Thissen indicated that South Eatherton Road between Centaur Road and Wild Horse Creek Road (Rte. CC) is too narrow for tractor trailer trucks, making the roadway unsafe for other road users.

South Eatherton Road is a County maintained arterial road located within the City of Chesterfield. This road extends from Centaur Road southwardly to Wild Horse Creek Road. The city limit of Wildwood is along the western/northern right-of-way line of South Eatherton Road.

South Eatherton Road is a narrow roadway with steep grades and abrupt changes in horizontal alignment. Recent field observations by Departmental personnel revealed that tractor trailer trucks have difficulty travelling on this roadway. At times, tractor trailer trucks cross the double yellow centerline and/or their rear tires drop off the edge of the pavement.

In light of the above, we believe that through tractor trailer trucks should be prohibited on South Eatherton Road. Therefore, we ask that you request appropriate legislation to enact the following amendment to the Saint Louis County Traffic Code:

AM ORDINANCE

AMENDING TITLE XII SLCRO 1974 AS AMENDED, "TRAFFIC CODE," BY ENACTING AND ADDING ONE PROVISION TO SCHEDULE VI AND ONE PROVISION TO SCHEDULE XII.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 1206.030 SLCRO 1974 as amended, Schedule VI, Title XII SLCRO 1974, as amended (Intersection Stops) is hereby amended by enacting and adding thereto one new provision as follows:

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Section 1212.145 SLCRO 1974 as amended, Schedule XII, Title XII SLCRO 1974, as amended (Regulation of the Kinds and Classes of Traffic on Certain Roads) is hereby amended by enacting and adding thereto one new provision as follows:

SECTION 3. The Director of Highways and Traffic is hereby authorized and directed to remove or post and install the necessary signs in accordance with Sections 1 and 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Every person, firm or corporation found guilty of violating Section 1 or 2 of this ordinance shall be punished as provided in Sections 1214.020 and 1215.010 SLCRO 1974 as amended.
