SUBJECT: Parking Restriction – Appalachian Trail at Duxbury Way

We received a request from a resident at 15478 Duxbury Way to restrict parking along the south side of Appalachian Trail, both east and west of Duxbury Way. The resident stated that when the athletic field at Shenandoah Valley Elementary was in use, vehicles park along the south side of Appalachian Trail, which blocks the view of a motorist trying to pull out of Duxbury Way onto Appalachian Trail. Per City Council policy, the request was sent to the trustees of the Shenandoah Subdivision. The trustees have indicated that they support the parking restriction.

Therefore, staff requests the Planning & Public Works Committee to recommend approval of the attached ordinance which will restrict parking along the south side of Appalachian Trail, both east and west of Duxbury Way, for a distance of 75 feet from the intersection, and to forward to City Council for their consideration.
