AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 300.530 OF THE CHESTERFIELD CITY CODE TO PROHIBIT PARKING OF LARGE BOATS, CAMPERS, MOTOR HOMES AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES IN EXCESS OF ONE HOUR PER CALENDAR DAY ON PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield seeks to promote the safe operation of vehicles and provide for safe pedestrian travel within the publicly maintained rights-of-way; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield seeks to promote safety and provide for appropriate parking; and,

WHEREAS, parking large vehicles on public streets obstructs the view of other motorists and can lead to accidents; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield is continuously concerned with the aesthetics of its community and desires to avoid visual clutter and large vehicles parking within the public rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield seeks to replace Section 300.530 in its entirety, replacing it with an amended section which prohibits parking large vehicles on public streets.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. This ordinance shall be codified as section 300.530 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chesterfield.

Section 300.530 shall be removed in its entirety and replaced as follows:

300.530 Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets.

1. When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets described by ordinance.
2. No person shall park or leave any boat, camper, trailer, motor home or commercial vehicle which is more than;
 - a. twenty-five (25) feet in length; or,
 - b. nine (9) feet in height; or,
 - c. eight (8) feet in width,on any roadway for a period of more than one (1) hour in any one (1) calendar day, except in an emergency or when in the process of loading or unloading the vehicle. As used herein, "roadway" shall mean any paved or improved portion of the road, including shoulders, intended for use by the general vehicular traveling public which portion is typically delineated by curbs, edge lines, or the edge of pavement improvements.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

RE: Request for Parking Prohibition on Both Sides of Wings of Hope Boulevard

Dear Mr. Dooley:

We received a request from Mr. John Bales, Director of Aviation, Spirit of St. Louis Airport, asking for the prohibition of parking on both sides of Wings of Hope Boulevard, from Spirit of St. Louis Boulevard to Olive Street Road. He indicated that the proposed parking prohibition is needed to prevent large trucks from continuing to park on Wings of Hope Boulevard.

The only tenant along Wings of Hope Boulevard is the Wings of Hope charity. Departmental personnel contacted Ms. Sara Stover, Administrative Manager of Wings of Hope, regarding this matter. Ms. Stover indicated that she is in favor of the proposed parking prohibition.

Therefore, we ask that you request appropriate legislation to enact the following amendment to the Saint Louis County Traffic Code:



AN ORDINANCE

CHANGING THE STREET NAME OF A PORTION OF AVIATION MUSEUM BOULEVARD TO WINGS OF HOPE BOULEVARD AND A PORTION TO OLIVE STREET ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Aviation Museum Boulevard, a public road within the city limits of the City of Chesterfield maintained by St. Louis County as a part of the St. Louis County Arterial Road System (ARS), shall hereafter be re-named and known as "Wings of Hope Boulevard," from Spirit of St. Louis Boulevard, westwardly and northwardly to Olive Street Road, a distance of approximately 0.37 mile.

SECTION 2. Aviation Museum Boulevard, a public road within the city limits of the City of Chesterfield maintained by St. Louis County as a part of the St. Louis County Arterial Road System (ARS), shall hereafter be re-named and known as "Olive Street Road," from Wings of Hope Boulevard (formerly Aviation Museum Boulevard) at existing Olive Street Road, northwardly to Chesterfield Airport Road, a distance of approximately 0.02 mile.

AN ORDINANCE APPENDING SECTION 300 MODEL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, SCHEDULE IX - PARKING RESTRICTIONS OF THE CHESTERFIELD CITY CODE TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON WINGS OF HOPE BOULEVARD WITHIN THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield seeks to promote the safe operation of vehicles and provide for safe pedestrian travel within the publicly maintained rights-of-way; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield seeks to promote safety and provide for appropriate parking; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Chesterfield seeks to append Section 300 Model Traffic Ordinance Schedule IX Parking Restrictions by adding a provision to restrict parking on Wings of Hope Boulevard at any time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 300 Model Traffic Ordinance - Schedule IX - Parking Restrictions of the Chesterfield City Code is hereby appended by adding a provision thereto as follows:

*Part of Road or Street Where
Parking is Regulated*

Parking restrictions

Wings of Hope Boulevard

No Parking - Anytime

From its intersection with Spirit of St. Louis Boulevard,
Westwardly and Northwardly to Olive Street Road

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
