Parking Restriction on Premium Way and Outlet Blvd

As you are well aware, the St. Louis Premium Outlets development necessitated the construction of two public streets, Premium Way and Outlet Boulevard. These streets connect Olive Street Road to the parking areas for St. Louis Premium Outlets. Premium Way and Outlet Boulevard were never designed to accommodate parking. Accordingly, Schedule IX of the City's Model Traffic Ordinance needs to be revised to include this parking restriction.
