V. APPROVAL OF MEETING SUMMARY

<u>Commissioner Tilman</u> made a motion to approve the Meeting Summary of the February 11, 2019 Planning Commission Meeting. The motion was seconded by <u>Commissioner Wuennenberg</u> and <u>passed</u> by a voice vote of 7 to 0.

VII. SITE PLANS, BUILDING ELEVATIONS AND PLATS

A. <u>Chesterfield Ridge Center, Parcel VIII, Building Group I Lot A (Kiddie</u> <u>Academy)</u>: A Site Development Section Plan, Landscape Plan, Lighting Plan, Architectural Elevations and Architect's Statement of Design for a 1.4 acre tract of land zoned "C-8" Planned Commercial District located at the northeast corner of the intersection of Chesterfield Parkway West and Hilltown Village Center.

<u>Commissioner Wuennenberg</u>, representing the Site Plan Committee, made a motion recommending approval of the Site Development Section Plan, Landscape Plan, Lighting Plan, Architectural Elevations and Architect's Statement of Design for <u>Chesterfield Ridge Center</u>, Parcel VIII, Building Group I Lot A (Kiddie <u>Academy</u>). The motion was seconded by <u>Commissioner Tilman</u>.

Discussion

It was noted that The Applicant has substantially met all of the recommendations proposed by the Architectural Review Board, including improvements to the facings of the property. A summary of the discussions held at the earlier Site Plan Committee Meeting was then provided:

- Discussion regarding landscaping between the parking lot and fence wherein it was confirmed that there is not adequate space for additional landscaping within the current physical restrictions. It was noted that the Applicant has added landscaping to the perimeter of the site.
- Substantial discussion related to the parking ingress and egress of the facility wherein it was clarified that the site does not include a circular drop-off/pick-up area. The site is designed whereby parents park and walk into the facility to drop off and pick up their children, which alleviated concerns regarding parking access. It was also explained that the facility intends to contact neighboring properties to assist with overflow parking during special events.
- It was confirmed that sidewalks cover the perimeter of the Kiddie Academy site.

<u>Commissioner Tilman</u> asked for clarification on how much of the cross access between the hotel parking lot and Hilltown Village Center will be constructed as part of the subject project. <u>Mr. Justin Wyse</u>, Director of Planning & Development Services, replied that the entire connection will be constructed with this project.

The vote on the above motion to approve <u>passed</u> by a voice vote of 7 to 0.
