

RE: Burkhardt Place - Parking Restriction & Bike Lanes



During its consideration of the parking restriction on October 21, 2021, the Planning and Public Works Committee of City Council (PPW) required that it be notified prior to the striping of the bike lanes on Burkhardt Place. Accordingly, I am requesting that this matter be referred to PPW so that it can authorize the striping of the bike lanes prior to Burkhardt Place being open to the public. Once the bike lanes are striped the parking restriction will be signed and formally implemented. The minutes from the October 21, 2021 PPW meeting are attached for your reference.

If you have questions or require additional information please let me know.

Action Recommended

This matter should be forwarded to the Planning and Public Works Committee of City Council so that PPW can authorize the striping of bike lanes on Burkhardt Place. Once the bike lanes are striped the parking restriction will be signed and formally implemented.

Please forward to PPW for review and authorization.

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Note: striping is the responsibility of the developer and any delay would result in the City incurring additional expense for striping.

RE: Bike Lane Striping on Burkhardt Place

The parking restriction for Burkhardt Place was approved by City Council at their November 15, 2021 meeting and was codified by ordinance 3169 (attached). Per ordinance 3169, the trigger for implementation of the parking restriction is the striping of the bike lanes on existing Burkhardt Place and the Burkhardt Place extension opening to traffic.

At the October 21, 2021 Planning and Public Works Committee Meeting, the Committee required that the bike lanes on the existing portion of Burkhardt Place not be striped until the Committee authorized Staff to do so (see attached PPW minutes).

The construction manager for Wildhorse Village, Clayco, provide the City with a schedule for completing and opening Burkhardt Place. Based on their schedule, the earliest that Burkhardt Place could open to traffic is June 6, 2022.

Accordingly, Staff is requesting authorization from the Planning and Public Works Committee for Clayco to stripe the bike lanes on the existing portion of Burkhardt Place such that the Burkhardt Place extension can be opened to traffic as soon as June 6, 2022.

Prior to the opening of the Burkhardt Place extension to traffic, City Staff will install no parking signs per the attached exhibit. No parking signs shall be R7-9 "No Parking Bike Lane" 12"x18" signs.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE III, SCHEDULE VII PARKING RESTRICTIONS OF THE CHESTERFIELD CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADDING PROVISIONS THERETO TO RESTRICT PARKING ON BURKHARDT PLACE.

WHEREAS, construction of Burkhardt Place will be completed between Wild Horse Creek Road and Chesterfield Parkway West as part of the Wildhorse Village development; and

WHEREAS, the roadway width will accommodate two driving lanes and designated bicycle lanes; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2520 for the West County YMCA included a condition restricting parking on both side of Burkhardt Place

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Schedule VII: Parking Restrictions of Title III of the Code of the City of Chesterfield is hereby amended by adding provisions thereto as follows:

Part of Road or Street Where Parking is Regulated

Parking Restriction

Burkhardt Place, both sides, between Chesterfield Parkway West and Wild Horse Creek Road

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No parking anytime

Section 2. In all other respects, Title III is in full force and effect.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at such time the Burkhardt Place extension is open for public use and Burkhardt Place has been striped for bicycle lanes.


Burkhardt Place

Limits of No Parking Restriction




October 21, 2021 PPW Minutes


Councilmember Hurt made a motion to forward to City Council an Ordinance that amends Title III, Schedule VII Parking Restrictions of the Chesterfield City Code of Ordinances by adding provisions to restrict parking on Burkhardt Place and to revise Section 3 to read "This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at such time that the Burkhardt Place extension is open for public use and Burkhardt Place has been striped for bicycle lanes." Striping of the bicycle lanes on the existing portion of Burkhardt Place will not be completed until the Planning & Public Works Committee authorizes Staff to do so. The motion was seconded by Councilmember DeCampi and passed by a voice vote of 4-0.


Planning & Public Works Committee Meeting Summary October 21, 2021
