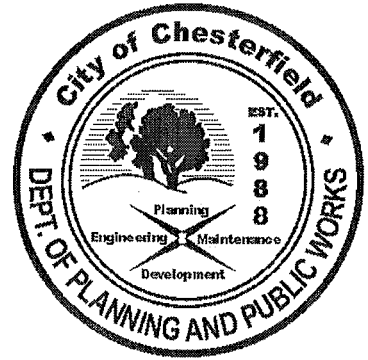

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 35, SCHEDULE III OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD BY ESTABLISHING SPECIAL SPEED LIMITS ON LYDIA HILL DRIVE AND AUGUST HILL DRIVE.**

WHEREAS, it is desirable to have a uniform speed limit on the entire length of roadway that is consistent with the nature of traffic and geometrics of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the speed limit on streets in Chesterfield is 25 mph except as provided for by ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance Number 35, Section 3, Schedule III, Special Speed Limits on County Highways, Roads or Streets, is hereby amended by adding provisions thereto as follows:

<u>Location</u>	<u>Speed Limit</u>
Lydia Hill Drive	30 mph
August Hill Drive	30 mph

Section 2. In all other respects, Ordinance Number 35 is in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
