# VII. SITE PLANS, BUILDING ELEVATIONS AND PLATS

A. <u>Chesterfield Village Mall (Watermark at Chesterfield Village) SDP</u>: A Site Development Plan, Landscape Plan, Lighting Plan, Architectural Elevations and Architect's Statement of Design for a 12.96 acre tract of land zoned "R-8" Residence District with a Planned Environment Unit (PEU) procedure located southeast of the intersection of Chesterfield Parkway West and Lydia Hill Road.

<u>Chair Proctor</u>, representing the Site Plan Committee, made a motion recommending approval of the Site Development Plan, Landscape Plan, Lighting Plan, Architectural Elevations and Architect's Statement of Design for <u>Chesterfield</u> <u>Village Mall (Watermark at Chesterfield Village)</u> with the proviso that the Petitioner will replace the Bradford Pears with other trees as approved by the City Arborist. The motion was seconded by <u>Commissioner Geckeler</u> and <u>passed</u> by a voice vote of 5 to 0.

B. <u>Chesterfield Commons West, Outlot 4 (Raising Cane's) SDSP</u>: A Site Development Section Plan, Landscape Plan, Tree Stand Delineation, Tree Preservation Plan, Lighting Plan, Architectural Elevations and Architect's Statement of Design for a 2.08 acre tract of land zoned "PC" Planned Commercial District located west of RHL Drive, south of its intersection with Chesterfield Airport Road.

<u>Chair Proctor</u>, representing the Site Plan Committee, made a motion recommending approval of the Site Development Section Plan, Landscape Plan, Tree Stand Delineation, Tree Preservation Plan, Lighting Plan, Architectural Elevations and Architect's Statement of Design for <u>Chesterfield Commons West</u>, <u>Outlot 4 (Raising Cane's)</u>. The motion was seconded by <u>Commissioner Lueking</u> and <u>passed</u> by a voice vote of 4 to 1 with Commissioner Geckeler voting "no".

C. <u>MPD Investments, Adjusted Lot 2 (Beyond Self Storage at</u> <u>Chesterfield) SDSP</u>: A Site Development Section Plan, Landscape Plan, Lighting Plan, Architectural Elevations, Architect's Statement of Design, and Parking Modification for a 2.99 acre tract of land zoned "Pl" Planned Industrial District located north of North Outer 40 Road, west of its intersection with Boone's Crossing.

<u>Chair Proctor</u>, representing the Site Plan Committee, made a motion recommending approval of the Site Development Section Plan, Landscape Plan, Lighting Plan, Architectural Elevations, Architect's Statement of Design, and Parking Modification for <u>MPD Investments, Adjusted Lot 2 (Beyond Self Storage at Chesterfield)</u>. The motion was seconded by <u>Commissioner Geckeler</u> and <u>passed</u> by a voice vote of 5 to 0.
