**IV. PUBLIC HEARINGS –** Commissioner Banks read the "Opening Comments" for the Public Hearing.

A. <u>T.S.P. 24-2010 Clearwire US LLC (Drury Plaza Hotel):</u> A request to obtain approval for a Telecommunication Siting Permit for the purpose of adding an additional antenna canister and equipment on the roof of a "PC" Planned Commercial District-zoned tract of land located at 355 E. Chesterfield Center (18S230433

### STAFF PRESENTATION:

Ms. Annissa McCaskill-Clay, Lead Senior Planner stated the following:

- The subject site is zoned "PC" Planned Commercial and is governed by Ordinance 2281, which was passed in 2006.
- The governing ordinance for the site allows up to four users on the top of the Drury Plaza Hotel, as long as they are disguised antenna structures.
- The Petitioner is proposing to add a second canister to the site.
- The canisters are visible from the western elevation, which is the side facing Chesterfield Mall. They are not visible from Clarkson Road.
- The current user on the site is U.S. Cellular. Clearwire US would be the second user.

Responding to questions from Ms. Aimee Nassif, Planning & Development Services Director, Ms. McCaskill-Clay noted the following:

- The height of the current canister on the rooftop is 132 feet from the top of the canister down to the grade elevation. The canister is 13' tall.
- The canisters are made to fit one particular user but the City's Ordinance specifies that there can be no more than four users for the entire building.
