## SUBJECT: Parking Restriction - Wildhorse Parkway Drive

Currently, there are no parking signs along both sides of Wildhorse Parkway Drive from Wild Horse Creek Road, south to the city limit line. When reviewing the Traffic Code, we determined that this no parking restriction was missing. For some reason, the parking restriction was never adopted by ordinance, which is why it is not included in the Traffic Code.

We then began to review the need for this parking restriction by discussing with the Police Department, the Monarch Fire District, and a trustee of Wildhorse subdivision. We determined that the restriction is warranted in the area where the center medians exist due to the width of the road. With Wildhorse Parkway Drive being the only means of ingress and egress, this area should remain free of parked vehicles to allow emergency vehicles, specifically fire trucks, to safely navigate the road. However, after the medians, the roadway widens, and provides adequate room to allow parking, without interfering with the ability of emergency vehicles to pass, thus the parking restriction south of the medians can be lifted.

Therefore, staff requests the Planning & Public Works Committee to recommend approval of the attached ordinance which will restrict parking on Wildhorse Parkway Drive, for a distance of approximately 2300 feet south of Wild Horse Creek Road, and to forward to City Council for their consideration.
