located south of Olive Street Road and east of Wardenburg.

PROPOSAL SUMMARY

Stock & Associates, on behalf of Spirit Valley Development, L.L.C. has submitted an Amended Site Development Concept Plan for the above referenced project. The request proposes 22 lots to be created on the site. The original approval of the Site Development Concept Plan proposed 16 lots within the development.

BACKGROUND

Spirit Valley Business Park is a 52.82 acre tract of land located south of Olive Street Road and east of Wardenburg. The subject property was rezoned from a "NU" Non-Urban District to a "PI" Planned Industrial District in June of 2007 under the terms and conditions of the City of Chesterfield Ordinance 2373. The ordinance has been amended twice (2008 and 2013) to amend uses permitted within the development.

A Site Development Concept Plan was approved for the development in October of 2007; which, among other items, served as the Preliminary Plat for the subdivision. A Record Plat, substantially complying with the approved Site Development Concept Plan was approved by the City in April of 2008 officially subdividing the property into 16 lots.

Four buildings within the development have been constructed to date (Lots 10, 11, 12, and 15) and Lot 1A has a plan approved for construction (construction has not yet begun).

SUBMITTAL INFORMATION

As mentioned previously, the proposed amendment to the Site Development Concept Plan proposes to modify the previously approved lot configuration and add six additional lots. Under the City of Chesterfield's process, the Site Development Concept Plan serves as the first step in the subdivision process. Therefore, prior to submittal of future plats such as lot splits and boundary adjustments, Staff has required the submittal of an Amended Site Development Concept Plan so that future submittals to modify property boundaries will substantially comply with the approved Amended Site Development Concept Plan.

The original Site Development Concept Plan for the development included submittal of a Conceptual Landscape Plan to show proposed landscaping along collectors and arterials (i.e. Olive Street Road). A general note has been included on the Amended Site Development Concept Plan that the amended plan does not propose changes to the previously approved Conceptual Landscape Plan and that the Plan recorded in Book 355, Page 756 is still the plan of record.

Additionally, no change to the street lighting is included with the proposed amendment. As such, a lighting plan is not included. Street lights will continue to be installed throughout the development as previously approved.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed the submittal and has found the proposal to be in compliance with the site specific ordinance and all City Code requirements. The Planning and Development Services Division recommends approval of the Amended Site Development Concept Plan.

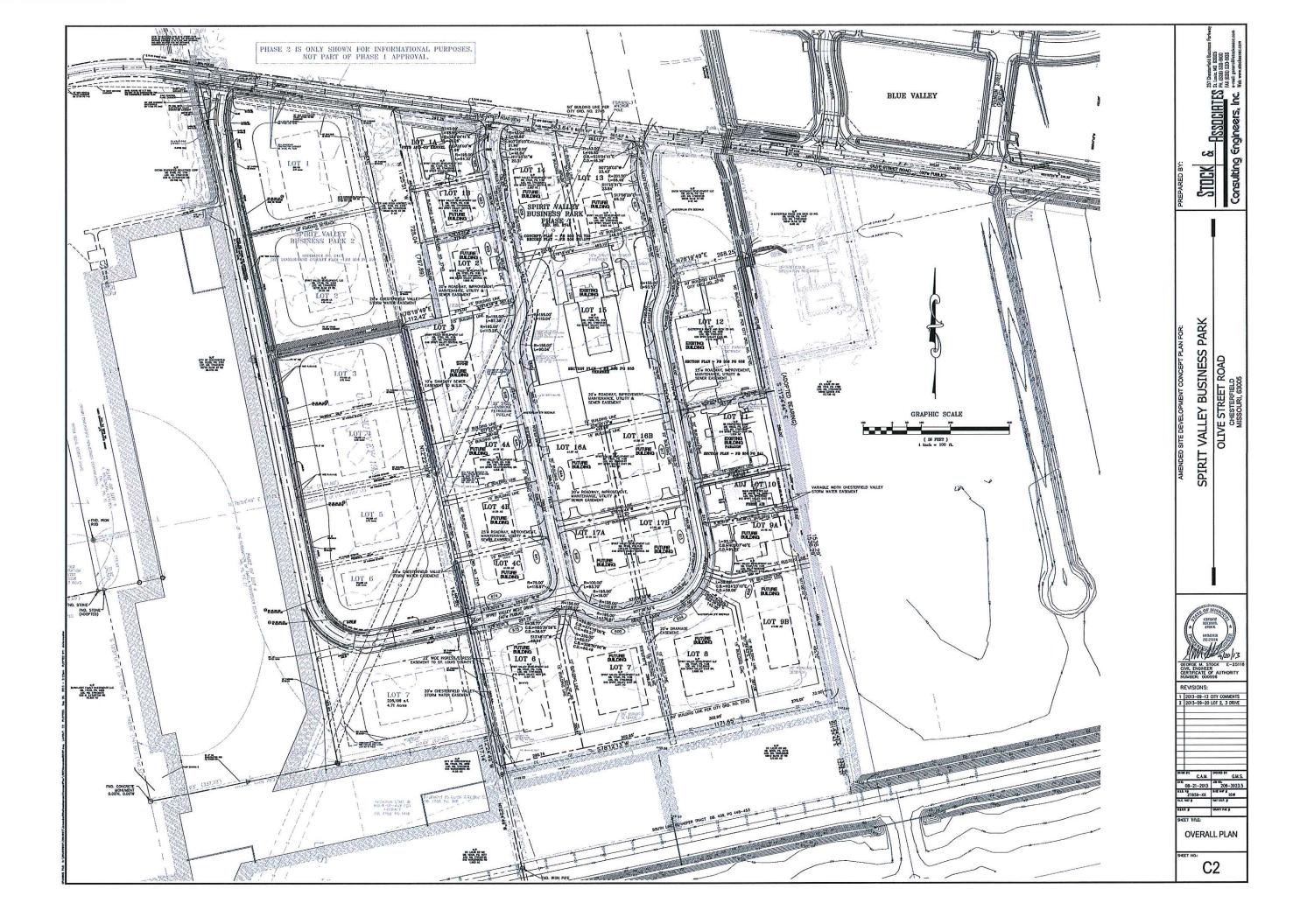
