SUBJECT: Planning & Public Works Committee Virtual Meeting Summary Thursday, September 24, 2020



A meeting of the Planning and Public Works Committee of the Chesterfield City Council was held virtually via Zoom on Thursday, September 24, 2020.

In attendance were: Chair Dan Hurt, (Ward III), Councilmember Mary Monachella (Ward I), Councilmember Mary Ann Mastorakos (Ward II) and Councilmember Michelle Ohley (Ward IV).

Also in attendance were: Mayor Bob Nation; Councilmember Michael Moore (Ward III); Planning Commission Chair Merrell Hansen; Mike Knight, Assistant City Planner; Annisa Kumerow, Planner; and Kathy Juergens, Recording Secretary.

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m.

I. APPROVAL OF MEETING SUMMARY

A. Approval of the September 10, 2020 Committee Meeting Summary

<u>Councilmember Mastorakos</u> made a motion to approve the Meeting Summary of September 10, 2020. The motion was seconded by <u>Councilmember Monachella</u> and <u>passed</u> by a voice vote of 3-0(Councilmember Ohley abstained).

II. UNFINISHED BUSINESS – None.

III. NEW BUSINESS

A. <u>Downtown Chesterfield (Category A and B) SDCP-Infrastructure Only</u>: A Site Development Concept Plan for infrastructure only on a 78.4 acre tract of land located south of Wild Horse Creek Road, west of Chesterfield Parkway West, and north and east of Burkhardt Place. (Ward 2)

STAFF PRESENTATION

<u>Mike Knight</u>, Assistant City Planner, stated that this is a Site Development Concept Plan (SDCP) for review. This is the first of a series of plans for the Wildhorse development and only depicts the general location of infrastructure, i.e., roadways and sewers. Following this plan, there will be a Site Development Concept Plan for the whole site that includes lots, lighting, landscaping, parking and amenities.

Review Components of this SDCP

• The roadway network conforms to the approved Preliminary Development Plan.

- The proposed plan incorporates all the recommended improvements that were provided in the traffic impact study.
- Outside agency approval has been received.
- The proposed plan depicts the same tree removals as the Preliminary Development Plan.

At the September 14, 2020 Planning Commission meeting, the Planning Commission recommended approval by a vote of 7-0 after some general discussion regarding tree removal and the view corridors.

Discussion

There was some discussion regarding the Committee's expectations regarding future plans. They included the following:

- Eliminate parking within view corridors
- Include a view of the lake within the view corridors
- Increase pedestrian connectivity to the lake
- Allow for more public access to the retail businesses

<u>Councilmember Ohley</u> made a motion to forward Downtown Chesterfield (Category A and B) SDCP-Infrastructure Only, with the expectation that the developer will address the Committee's areas of concern in future plans, to City Council with a recommendation to approve. The motion was seconded by <u>Councilmember Monachella</u> and <u>passed</u> by a voice vote of 4-0.
