Chesterfield issues renewal notices to all licensed businesses in the City via mail the first week of May. Licenses expire each June $30^{\text {th }}$, and a 30 day grace period lapses on July $31^{\text {st }}$ before businesses are in violation.

Renewal notices verify each businesses square footage and state the charge per square foot. Chesterfield charges different rates for retail (\$0.08/sqft), service ( $\$ 0.04 / \mathrm{sqft}$ ), and Manufacturing/Warehousing ( $\$ 0.02 / \mathrm{sqft}$ ) - there is a minimum $\$ 25$ fee. In 2016 a total of $\$ 599,326$ in license fees have been collected thus far, compared to a total of $\$ 623,767$ in 2015.

We have a maximum license fee of $\$ 10,000$ and 9 businesses reach that threshold: Monsanto, Doubletree, RGA, Target, Sears, Wal-Mart, Sam's, Macy's, and Dillards. The $10^{\text {th }}$ highest business license fee is paid by Lowe's, at $\$ 9,636.56$ in 2015.
