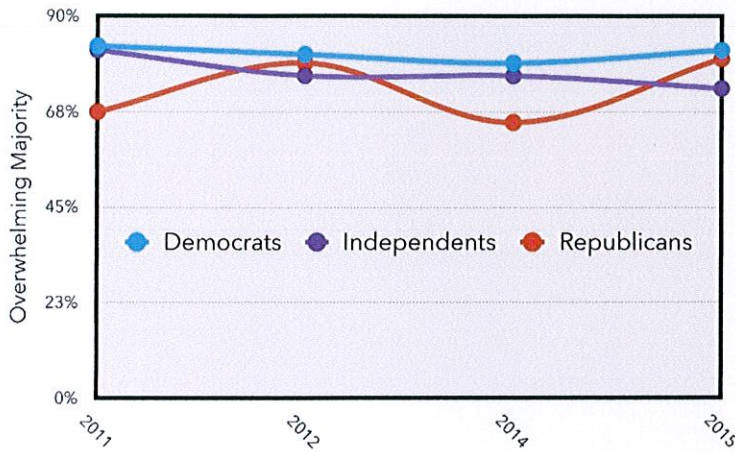

200 MOST POLITICALLY ACTIVE COMPANIES IN AMERICA "CASH IN" INFLUENCE



"After examining 14 million records, including data on campaign contributions, lobbying expenditures, federal budget allocations and spending, we found that, on average, for every dollar spent on influencing politics, the nation's most politically active corporations received \$760 [\$758] from the government. The \$4.4 trillion total represents two-thirds of the \$6.5 trillion that individual taxpayers paid into the federal treasury.

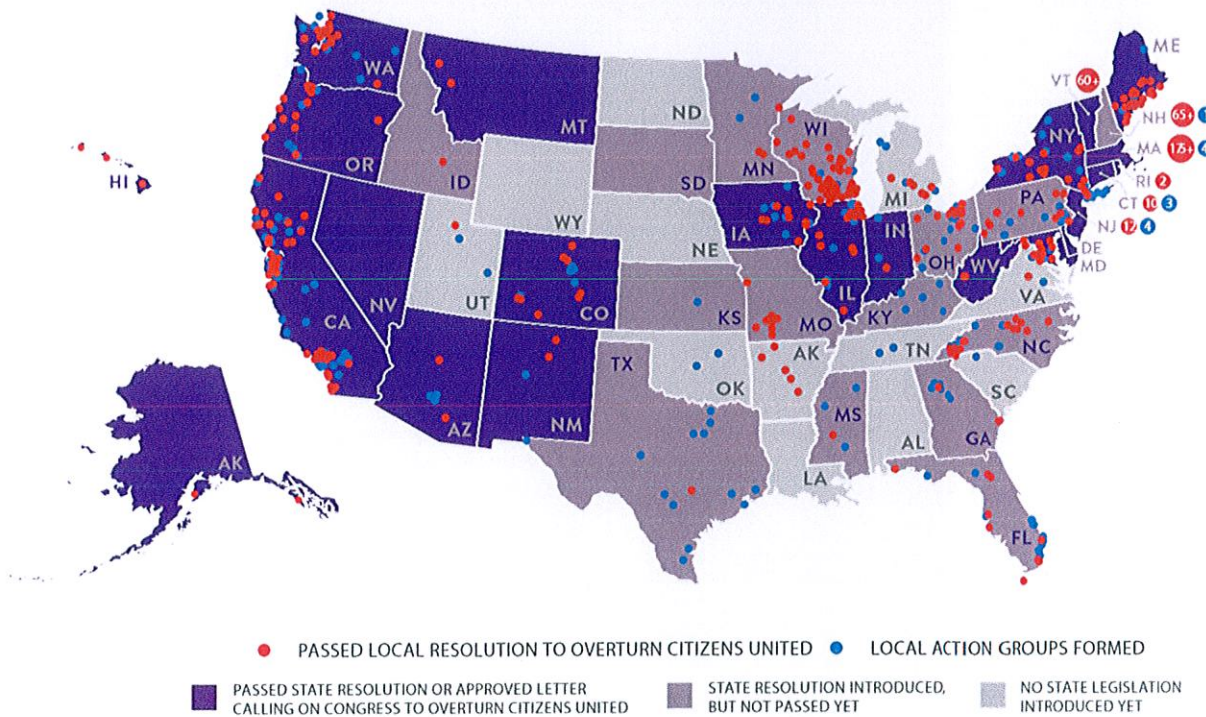
