# 2. Obscenity Ordinance

The Committee will consider a proposed Obscenity Ordinance which combines the substantive elements of previously proposed Ordinances 2327 and 2328. This proposed ordinance creates a municipal offense for the public display of obscene material and material harmful to minors.

#### 3. Borders Ordinance

The Committee will consider a proposed ordinance prohibiting the renting of rooms in a single family dwelling.

#### 4. Proposed Revision to Municipal Code Section 4 – 11 relating to minors and intoxicating liquor

In 2005 the Missouri State Legislature amended the Statutes addressing intoxication by minors. The Committee will consider a proposed revision to amend the current municipal ordinance to coincide with the State's current regulations.

## 5. Motorized Play Vehicles

The Committee will consider a proposed ordinance (as amended) to regulate the use of motorized play vehicles.

## 5. Portable On-Demand Storage Units

The Committee will consider a proposed ordinance regulating the placement of portable ondemand storage in or near public rights of way.
