



## RECORD OF PROCEEDING

---

### SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHESTERFIELD AT 922 ROOSEVELT PARKWAY, APRIL 26, 1993

---

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 P.M.

A roll call was taken with the following results:

Mayor Jack Leonard recognized City Attorney Doug Beach. Mr. Beach stated that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss and adopt Resolution #130 which declares the intention of the City of Chesterfield to annex (or re-annex) an area of land that is contiguous to the City of Chesterfield along its eastern border. Controversy has arisen over the legality of the Boundary Commission. Mr. Beach stated that he believes in the validity of this eastern annexation that was approved by the Boundary Commission. However, he indicated that it would be appropriate, at this point in time, to initiate a process to re-annex this area.


Director of Planning Jerry Duepner next presented the details of the area to be annexed. Mr. Duepner noted that 52% of its total perimeter shares a common boundary with the City of Chesterfield and exceeds the percentage required by State law. Mr. Duepner reported that a preliminary Plan of Intent has been distributed to the Mayor and all Councilmembers for their review. It was noted that the City has been providing services to this area since May, 1992.

Councilmember Levinson stated his desire to extend the boundaries to include a parcel of land that is currently in the City of Town and Country. There was much discussion. A motion was then made by Councilmember Hurt, seconded by Councilmember Greenwood, to adopt Resolution #130 and to set a Public Hearing for June 21, 1993, at 6:30 P.M. A roll call vote was taken with the following results: Ayes - Hilbert, Greenwood, Levinson,


Hurt and Tilley. Nays - None. Mayor Leonard declared the motion passed and Resolution #130 was adopted.
