

Minutes of CHLPC, Wednesday, 7/13/16

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Tom Rothwell at 5:45. In attendance were Tom, Ann Chrissos, George Chrissos, DeeAnn Wright, Steve Domahidy, and Jane Durrell. Lynne Johnson and Anne Lewis were out of town.

The May minutes were read and approved.

The Financial Report was given by Treasurer DeeAnn Wright. The balance as of 6/30/16 is \$25,535.29.

A discussion was held on how to organize and inventory the contents of our main floor storage area. DeeAnn Wright suggested setting a date for a 6-hour work session in one room with a large table or several tables and spread out our museum pieces and archives, sorting them out and into labeled banker's boxes or plastic bins. Jane volunteered to take Dan Rothwell's contributions of documents home to sort and thin out. Tom will check with the Chrissos and Aimee to find a suitable date in the near fall.

Steve Domahidy suggested that tables be set up in the back of the Council Chambers for sorting and cataloging. He also asked about the availability of the basement storage room which had been assigned to the Historic Commission.

The History Day at the County Library Headquarters is Saturday, 8/20, 10-4, and we will have a table to man. All of our publications will be on display, although none can be sold there. Tom will send an e-mail sign-up sheet to everyone.

The Faust Park Heritage Festival is the weekend of 9/17 & 18 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and we will again be manning our table at some location there, and have all our publications there for sale. This is an annual event for Faust Historic Village and for CHLPC. Tom will send an e-mail sign-up sheet to everyone on this as well. Nell and Ted Goedecke have already volunteered for a morning shift.

Jane Durrell gave the 2017 calendar report. Advertisers have been slower to respond this year, but things are moving along well. Pictures have been selected, and target date for publication is Labor Day.

Tom asked Lynne Johnson to contact the St. Louis County Library about its donation process before the Committee gives the library money in memory of Nancy Greenwood.

George suggested that CHLPC join the Chesterfield Chamber of Commerce.
