FINANCIAL REPORT: Jane reported for the past 4 months. Income = \$564.00. Expenses = \$1,400.00 for HFC. Balance as of 6/28/22 = \$8,865.00. \$1,800 for 2023 calendar ads have been collected by 7/13/22. Steve proposed that the operational sub account of HFC for CHLPC should continue to be reported and the report should include the total in HFC's bank account. Cindy seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

MUSEUM REPORT: DeeAnn reported that the Eberwein house on Old Baxter Road is still on the market. She said the museum is doing well, but still needs more volunteers.

CALENDAR REPORT: George reported that the 2022 calendar made \$400 from ad sales. He has set up a spreadsheet for the 2023 calendar. New prices for ads are: Cover \$500, Banner \$300, Double Business Card \$200, Business Card \$100, Double Booster \$100, Single line Booster \$50. Mike reported that the 2023 cover will feature a collage of early Chesterfield churches.

SPEAKERS BUREAU: There have been no request for speakers.

HISTORY BOOKS: Mike reported that all history books have been transferred from Public Works to the museum.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Mike offered to check the date for the Faust Park Festival in September. He also announced that Mark Leach will be speaking on cave art at the City Community Center in September. Jane said her historic tour talk has been retrieved. She will determine which sites still exist.
