

CHESTERFIELD HISTORIC AND LANDMARKS PRESERVATION COMMITTEE

MINUTES FOR SEPTEMBER 9, 2020, 5:30PM

Jane Durrell brought the meeting to order at 5:30.

Michael Kane welcomed Councilmember Mastorakos as our Liaison.

Lynne Johnson made a motion that the CHLPC Minutes from July 8, 2020 (written by Ann Chrissos) be accepted. Second by Mike.

All approved

DeeAnn Wright presented the Treasurer's report from July 1, 2020 to August 31, 2020. The balance increased from \$15,015.40 on June 30 to \$16,305.40 on August 31. There was \$1,925 income from calendar ads and \$65 from book sales. There was a \$700 expense for the Museum rent.

DeeAnn made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and Erin Compton seconded. All approved.

Discussion followed on the number of 2021 Calendars that should be printed. It was generally thought that whereas we ordered 3,000 for the 2020 calendar, we should order only 2,000 because the Covid Pandemic will prevent us from our normal distribution locations. The committee voted for 2,000 copies with one vote for 2,500. Two thousand calendars will cost \$4,230 which is less than our income from 2021 calendar ads of \$5,250.

Anne Lewis, who has authored the 2021 calendar said it would go to the printers the next day and be ready for the Faust Park Festival on September 26 & 27.

Anne was thanked by all of us for putting together the calendar with new sources of pictures.

The Bi-Centennial Celebration plans so far are a City Hall Display on the history of Missouri, two articles for the Citizen, all of which are done by Ann Chrissos, and a display in August 2021 at the Sachs Library.

Lynne suggested that the City could celebrate the Bicentennial with a parade or masks engraved with the state of Missouri and 200 years.

George Chrissos let us know that Ann has written over 100 articles on Chesterfield families which are on the City web site. He also would like to add pictures from old calendars to "scroll" on the site.

Jane asked for volunteers to represent CHLPC at the Faust Park Festival at our table in the Bates House.

Saturday, September 26: Anne (10 - 12), Ann Chrissos (12 - 2) and DeeAnn (2 - 4).

Sunday, September 27: Mike (10 - 12), Jack Avery (12 - 2) and Lynne (2 - 4).

DeeAnn gave a report on the Museum. Rick represents the Mall. He said that the west wing where our Museum is now, will be closed off the end of October. The former Children's Museum on the second floor, next to Macys is available for us but it is much larger and we do not know what the utilities cost. Right now, the utilities are the main expense of the Museum.

Jane said that she has started a "Clippings Box" for any interesting Chesterfield newspaper articles.

Mike announced that the Woodchopper's Ball has been cancelled for 2021.

The officer elections will be held at the November 11 CHLPC meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 6:45.
