MEETING NOTES

1. OASIS Presentation & update - Sharon Hales, Community Outreach Manager and Allison Woodworth, Education Program Manager - *Sharon Hales stated there have been 202 enrollments in OASIS classes in Chesterfield this summer and 131 participants, so several who take multiple classes. They have 212 people from Chesterfield zip codes registered in their programs. They offer 20 classes at City Hall, which is about the maximum and will be looking for additional places to hold some classes in the future. They are very happy with the success here and the partnership.*
2. Status of Independent Transportation Network Discussion- Bonnie/Libbey/James/Stacy - *Libbey & Bonnie provided and update in stating that a Steering Committee has been formed with representatives from University City, St. Louis County, Richmond Heights, St. Louis NORC & Chesterfield. A meeting was held at City Hall on June 8. A service territory was defined as generally Highway 109 to the West, Manchester Road to the South, Page Avenue to the North and Skinker to the east. Chesterfield & St. Louis Co staff are evaluating need in those areas based on existing data and putting together a fact sheet to show need as well. The next meeting is July 13.*
3. Update on Participation in St. Luke's Community Health Fair-Bonnie
Bonnie stated this was a well attended event, although they were on a separate level that didn't get as much traffic. They were the only non-St. Luke's exhibitor there. Several sign-ups for the older adult information.
